| SDR 37726 | Previously, when you upgraded the BlackBerry Enterprise Server from 3.6 SP 1 to SP 4 on a computer running Microsoft Windows® 2003, a Windows logo message appeared, and the Programs > BlackBerry Enterprise Server > Edit the MAPI Profile for > BlackBerry Server Management shortcut was missing from the Start menu. |

| SDR 61321 | Previously, if an invitee accepted a meeting with a reminder on the BlackBerry device, the reminder field in the acceptance message was set to None when the organizer viewed it on the BlackBerry device. |
| SDR 59731 | Previously, if a meeting organizer modified the location of an instance for a recurring meeting, and an invitee accepted the update on the BlackBerry device, the acceptance message the organizer received did not show the location change in Microsoft Outlook®. |
